Job Overview

The Counseling position is a 10-15 hour per week contract position. Candidate will work closely with the DWAVE team to provide a safe, support system for our clients. Candidate needs to be companionate and have an understanding the role trauma plays with our clients for whom they are treating. Community outreach/education is important to us. Candidate must be comfortable with social media and public speaking.
